Scientix is managed by <u>European Schoolnet</u> (EUN) on behalf of the <u>European Commission</u> (DG Research).



Scientix collects teaching materials and research reports from European science education projects financed by the European Union

under the 6th and 7th Framework Programmes for Research and Technological Development (Directorate General Research), the Lifelong Learning Programme (Directorate General Education and Culture) and various national initiatives.



The portal collects all the materials from European Science projects and offers the teaching materials in any of the 23 official EC languages.



Its translation on demand feature allows for teachers to request the translation of a material they like - into Slovenian

(eg. they like a Physics animation available in Czech, they request its translation and it is for free).
